We try to provide as complete a picture of expenses as possible, but this is subject to change.

<p>Fees for Registration and Enrollment</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● NEW FAMILIES - \$350 per student, no maximum ● RE-ENROLLING FAMILIES - \$275 per student <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ If re-enrolling more than one student, the maximum registration fee is \$500 ○ If a new student is added, the maximum registration fee is \$525 ● Required Latin Intensive - all NEW TO SLOCA Level 6 students. Cost is \$60 per student. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ August 20 - August 21 - 9:00am - 12:00pm ● Required Latin/Writing Intensive - all NEW TO SLOCA Level 7 and 8 students. Cost is \$250 per student. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ August 20 - August 23 - 9:00am - 3:30pm ● Please Note: Registration fees are <u>non-refundable</u> unless SLOCA does not accept a student, the family does not receive sufficient financial aid, or SLOCA does not have openings for students enrolling.
<p>Yearly Tuition</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Pre/JrK: \$4,195/year full-day \$3,500/year half-day (<i>Half-day spots are available on a limited basis</i>) ● Kinder – Level 4: \$4,620 ● Levels 5 – 8 two-day program: \$5,140 ● Levels 5 – 8 four-day program: \$7,840 ● High School - three day program: \$7,785 ● Sibling discounts: 2 = 5% discount; 3 = 10%, 4 = lowest tuition is complimentary. Sibling discounts apply to tuition only - not Friday programs. Only one discount per family. ● Please Note: Tuition is a financial commitment you will be responsible for the entire school year.
<p>Curriculum Costs</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Curriculum costs are the responsibility of each family. All required curriculum is available in our school store. Curriculum costs vary, but the average cost is approximately \$500-\$700 per year. Curriculum is purchased each trimester (semester for high school) ● High School books vary according to class – textbooks are higher in price. We do work hard to provide used copies for sale. ● <i>Please support our community by purchasing your curriculum through our school store!! We work hard to provide competitive prices and as many used books as possible.</i> ● Please Note: Sales tax is not included in the above listed prices. We do have a buy-back program for some curriculum that may be used again the following year. School store staff will identify buy-back books.
<p>Supplies</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Preschool – Intermediate: In-class supplies are covered in your tuition cost. ● LMS – HS: Students will be given a list of supplies to purchase. ● ALL Families: Required to bring some general school supplies at the beginning of the year.



<p>Optional Educational & Enrichment Opportunities</p>	<p>There are several optional enrichment opportunities - sports, camping trips, field trips, and our Friday Programs. Costs vary depending on the opportunity. Please Note: If you enroll your students in these programs, you are committed to the cost for the length of the program.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Sports Programs are offered all 3 trimesters and both semesters for high school. Depending on the level of the student and the sport, costs can run from \$75 - \$250 per sport. • Field trips and camping trips: Upper Middle School and HS students have opportunity to attend camping trips. Cost of these trips vary depending on location and length of trip. There are also opportunities for field trips - shows at the PAC, museum visits, other trips to explore things we are studying, etc. <p><i>Friday Foundations, Friday Play Lab, Academy Classes, and Academy Clubs* - these programs are 8 Fridays each Trimester</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Academy Classes are a per trimester program commitment offered on Friday afternoons for Kinder thru Level 4.** Fees are: 1 class \$110, 2 classes \$170, 3 classes \$220 • Academy Clubs are a per year program commitment offered on Friday afternoons for Levels 4** thru 8. Fees are: \$405 for one club, \$765 for two clubs. • Friday Foundations are for levels 1 - 8. These costs will be added to your regular tuition on a monthly basis. Fees are: \$857 per year (morning only) or \$1410 per year (full day which includes afternoon Academy Classes/Clubs). • Friday Play Lab is for preschool - kinder students. Only full day option is available. Cost is: \$1410 per year. <p>* Academy Classes and Academy Clubs may have additional materials fees. ** Level 4 students may take either Academy Classes or Clubs</p>
<p>Other</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • There are two required parent meetings per year (August & January) for all parents.* • There are three mandatory parent trainings to assist you with your work at home with your students for Levels 1 - 8. There may also be a mandatory math training for levels (Kinder - 8).* • 15 volunteer hours per family are required each trimester. A \$16 fee per each incomplete hour will be assessed. • Safety Fee - \$250 per family. This charge will be split between your August and January statements. • Scrip is a way to offset your tuition. You may apply up to 75% of what the school makes from your scrip purchases to your account (or you may donate back to the school). • Fingerprinting – if you desire to volunteer at SLOCA and will be alone with the children, you must be fingerprinted. This cost varies, but typically is \$50 - \$90 depending on location. You will be responsible for the cost. <p>*If you cannot attend these meetings or the make-up video viewing, a \$30 fee will be assessed.</p>
