



New Family Checklist for Enrollment @ SLO Classical Academy

Kindergarten through Level 8

- Submission of required forms with the non-refundable registration fee of \$325 per student may be completed at any step in the enrollment process and will hold a place on the enrollment list. But all other steps must be finished before you will be considered for an open spot. Turn completed forms into:

- Meet with the Admissions Director and complete an observation and tour.
 - Schedule a day for your student/s to spend some time in a classroom.
 - Attend a Parent Preview Night – RSVP for the meeting you wish to attend. Meetings are scheduled as follows:
 - Monday, November 7, 2016, @ 7:00 pm - 165 Grand Avenue, SLO
 - Monday, February 6, 2017 @ 7:00 pm - 165 Grand Avenue, SLO
- Note: Attendance at a Parent Preview Night is a requirement of enrollment. If you miss both of the meetings, there will be a video available for viewing after the last meeting..*
- Complete the Intent to Enroll Packet. If you are enrolling for Kindergarten, copies of your kinder student's birth certificate and up-to-date vaccinations must be submitted. If a Level 7 student is enrolling, up-to-date immunizations must be submitted. All forms must be presented by July 1, 2017.
 - Include any specialized educational services evaluations or reports your student/s may have (academic, social emotional, behavioral, speech, etc.).
 - Complete the Family Interview with the Admissions Director and the Dean of Students at a later date. Levels 7 and 8 students are required to attend. Family Interviews typically start in February / March.
 - Complete student assessment for level placement. More information will come regarding this.
 - Two Student Recommendation forms must be completed for Level 7 and 8 students.
 - You will be notified as soon as possible if your family has been accepted (March – April timeframe). You are welcome to contact us at any time to check the status of your family's enrollment.

SLOCA can only accept a limited number of new students. Applications will be processed based on a number of factors: timeliness of application, family interview, and compatibility with our program. Although applications are accepted at any time, we encourage you to apply early to increase the possibility of a spot for your student/s. If we are unable to enroll your student on either track, you will be placed on a wait list. If your student does not receive placement, your registration fee will be returned.
