ID/S	Identification and Significance - UMS and HS	A method of responding to one's history reading which includes answering "who?", "what?", "when?", "where?", and most importantly, "What is the significance?"

PRs	Progress Reports	At trimesters 1 and 3, parents of students in K-UMS will write up a report on how their child has done on the home side of the educational partnership. Forms are provided and can be downloaded from the website. This is a time to reflect on the past trimester and set goals for the coming one. Fellow parents, teachers and staff are always willing to help if needed. Trimester 2 will have mandatory parent/teacher conferences.

Lead Team	Represents the whole school	Consists of the Executive Director, Director of Academic Life, Director of Community Life, High School Director, Preschool Director, Development Director, and Admissions and Parent Care Director. The Lead Team are in different offices all over the campus.
