ENROLLMENT CHECKLIST

- Attend one of our SLOCA Sneak Peek events - <https://sloclassical.org/our-events/> or watch this video from our last sneak peek <https://vimeo.com/806451322>. NOTE: Attendance at a Sneak Peek or viewing the video is a requirement for enrollment.
- Attend a family meeting/tour.** At this meeting, you and your student will meet with one of the Early Education Directors, have your questions answered, and take a tour of the Wonders Campus.
- Complete the online **Intent to Enroll Application** (<https://sloclassical.org/apply-to-sloca/>). Our enrollment process is completed online through FACTS. To submit your Intent to Enroll application, there is a one-time \$122 per student fee (\$22 FACTS submission fee + \$100 non-refundable application fee).
- Notification** will be made as soon as possible if your family has been accepted. Feel free to contact us at any time to check your enrollment status.

UPON RECEIVING YOUR ACCEPTANCE LETTER

- Complete your online **Enrollment Packet** linked in your acceptance letter.
- When electronically submitting your Enrollment Packet, you will be required to pay the non-refundable **\$375 Registration Fee**. *Your registration fee will be credited to your tuition account by November.*
- Complete the State-Required Licensing Packet and any other required forms, which include up-to-date vaccinations along with a physician's report. This packet must be completed, turned in, and reviewed by us before your student may start.

SLOCA can only accept a limited number of students. Applications will be processed based upon a number of factors: timeliness of application, campus visit, and compatibility with our program. Although applications are accepted at any time, we encourage you to apply early to increase the possibility of a spot for your student/s. In addition, please note that immunizations or a valid medical exemption letter are required.
